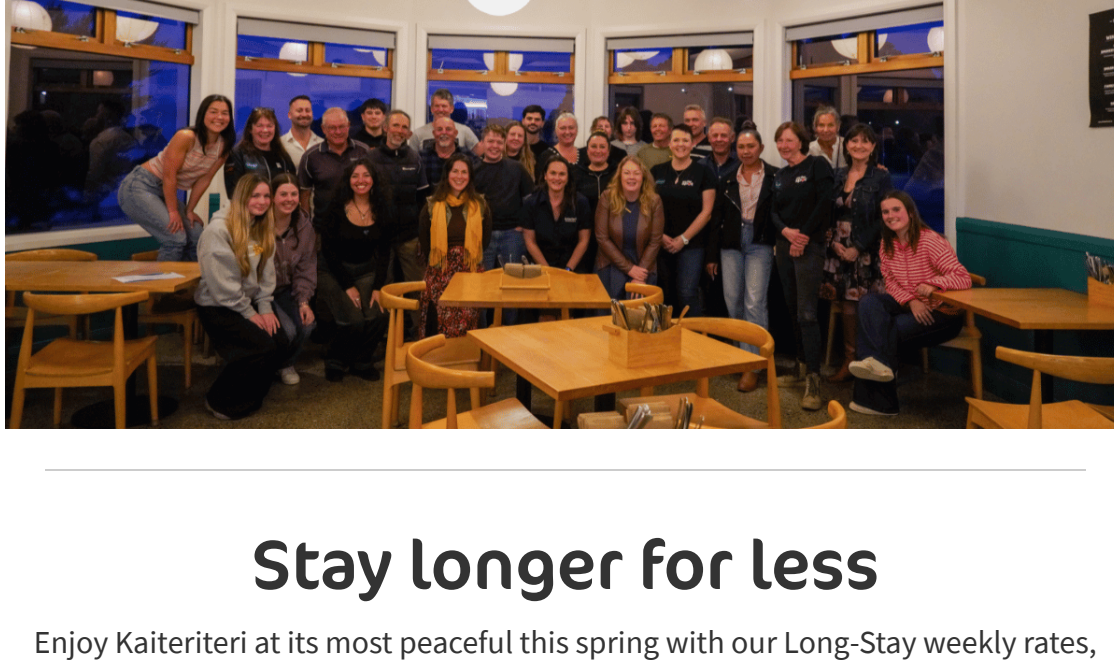
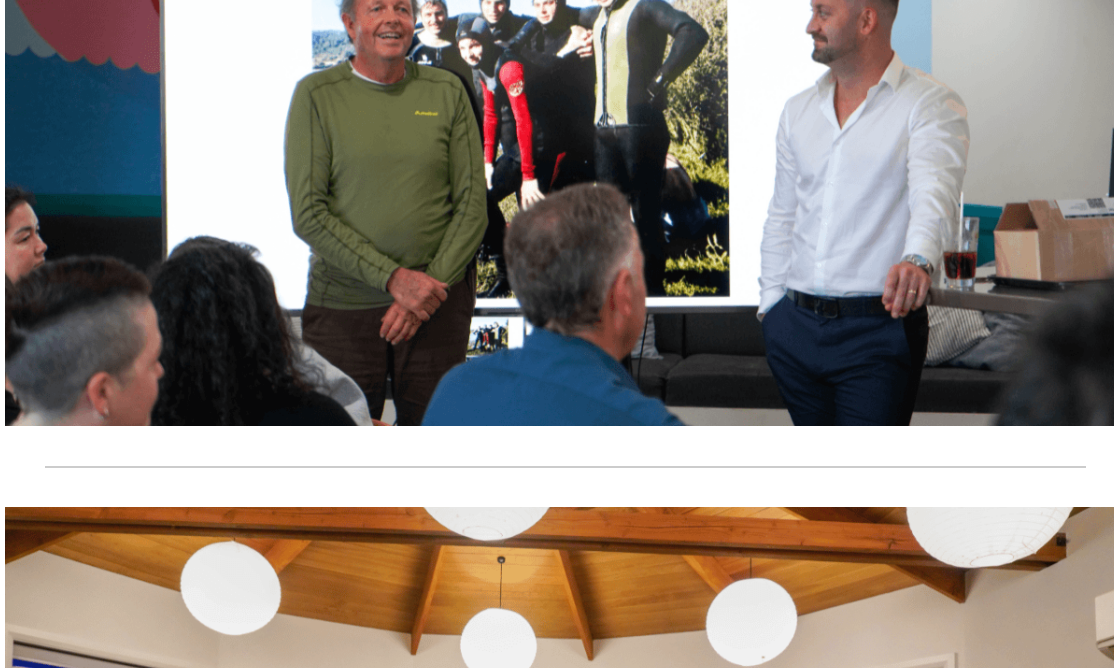
Farewell to Pete

Enjoy that golden Tasman sunset, you've certainly earned it!

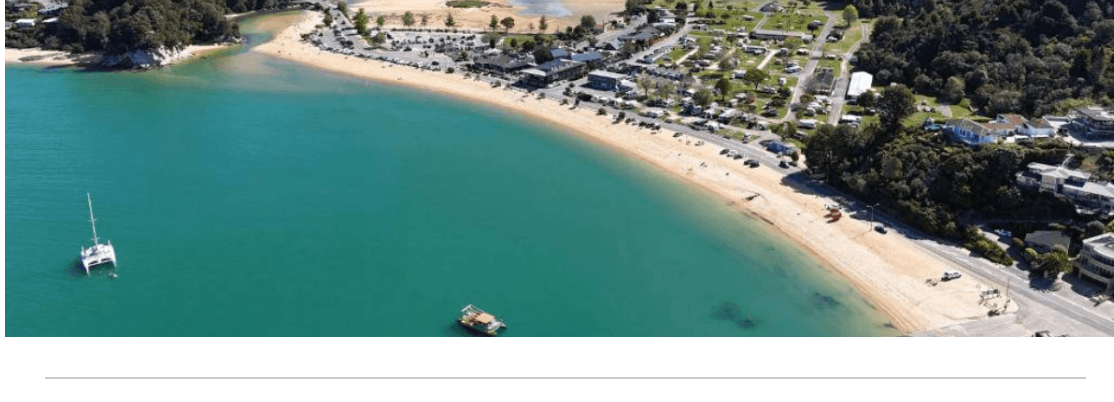


Stay longer for less

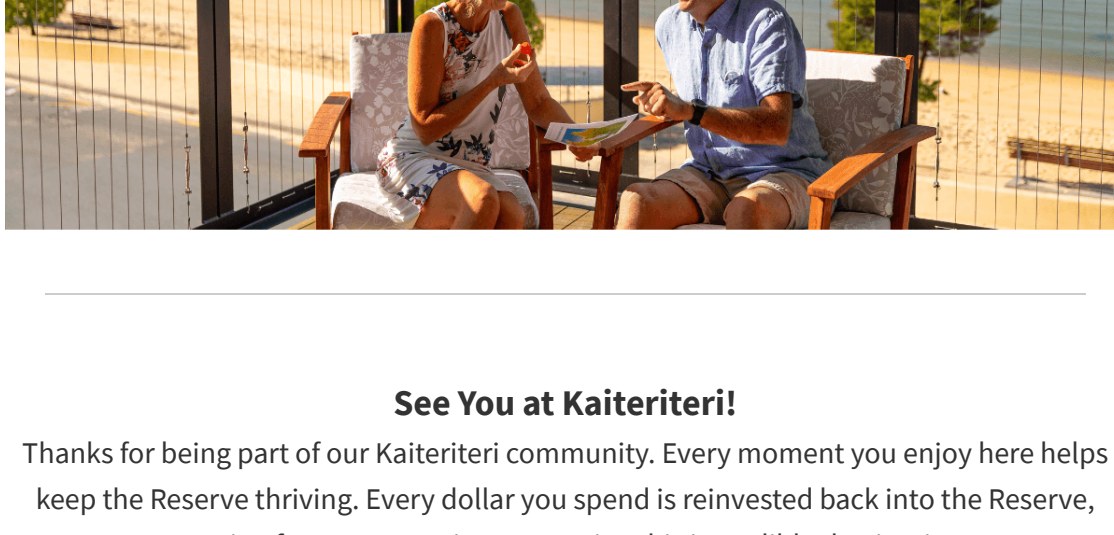
